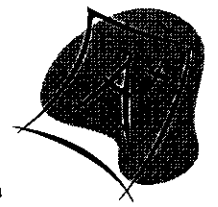




Parent Teacher Interviews and Report Card Pickup



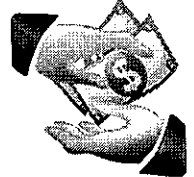

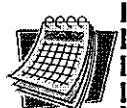

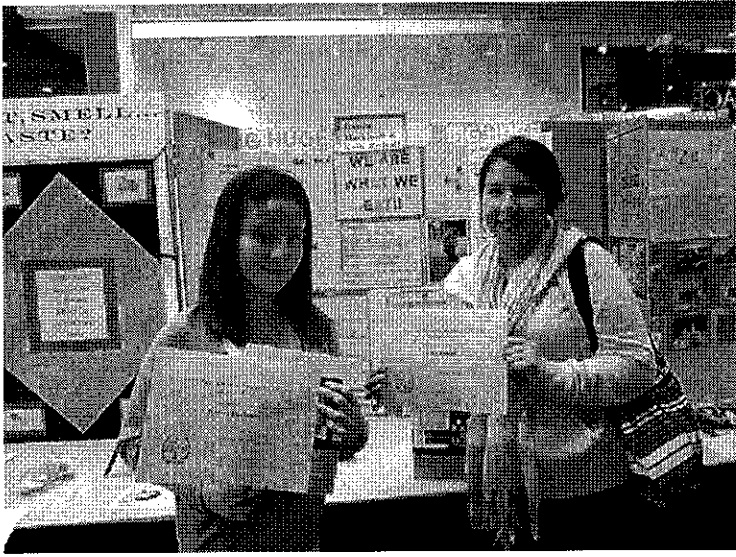

School Science Fair News!

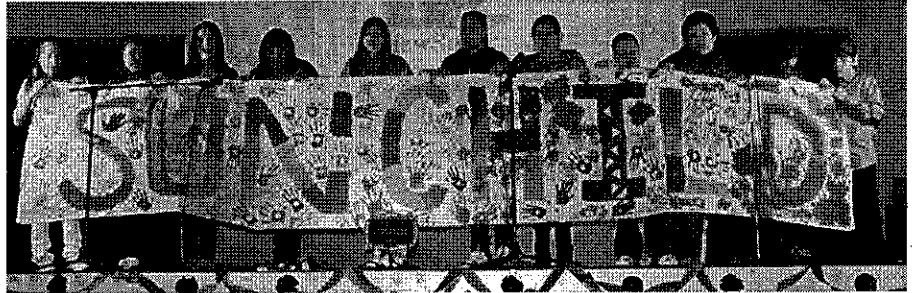
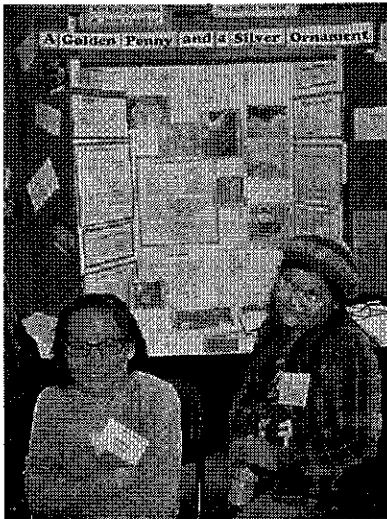
