

Tuesday April 23,2013 Everyone is invited to The O'Chiese Community center to hear a "Message of Hope and Healing". Two courageous men share their stories of overcoming victimization. The first speaker, First Nations activist Mike Gladue @ 3PM. Dinner @ 5pm, Theo Fleury at 6PM. Watch for posters!

Mike Gladue is originally from Edmonton — he spent nearly two decades struggling with drugs and alcohol, coping with sexual abuse he endured as a child. He spent time in and out of jail, but eventually found traditional ceremonies and became the founder of the Seven Generations Healing Network.

"Theo" Fleury (born June 29, 1968) is a Canadian former professional ice hockey player for the Calgary Flames, Colorado Avalanche, New York Rangers, and Chicago Blackhawks of the National Hockey League (NHL), Tappara of Finland's SM-liiga, and the Belfast Giants of the UK's Elite Ice Hockey League. He was drafted by the Flames in the 8th round, 166th overall, at the 1987 NHL Entry Draft, and played over 1,000 games in the NHL between 1989 and 2003.

He twice represented Canada at the Winter Olympics, winning a gold medal in 2002. Throughout his career, he battled drug and alcohol addictions that ultimately forced him out of the NHL in 2003, when he was only 35 years old. Outside of hockey, Fleury overcame his addictions, operated a concrete business in Calgary with
