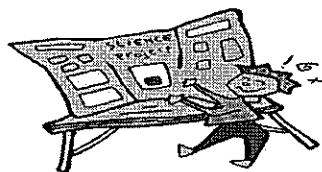

March 8th**



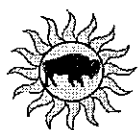

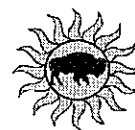
Above- Bridge Builders Bellow -Elementary Winners
