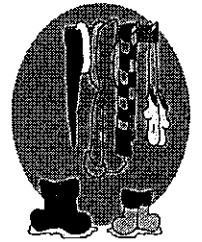
Student Attendance

Students needing retakes on their school pictures are required to bring back their first package uncut to get retakes.

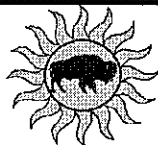

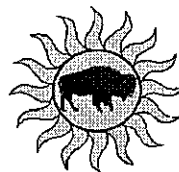
