#### **High School Hunting Camp**



#### Salt Dough Fun with Kids

#### Ingredients

1 cup salt 2 cups all purpose flour 1 cup luke warm water



#### Directions

1. In a large bowl mix salt and flour.

**2.** Gradually stir in water. Mix well until it forms a doughy consistency.

3. With your hands form a ball with your dough and kneed it for at least 5 minutes. The longer you kneed your dough the smoother it will be. You can **paint** your creations with acrylic paints and seal with varnish or polyurethane spray. You can let your salt dough creations air dry, however salt dough can also be dried in the oven. **Bake** at 200 F until your creation is dry.
