Salt Dough Fun with Kids

Ingredients

1 cup salt
2 cups all purpose flour
1 cup luke warm water



Directions

1. In a large bowl mix salt and flour.
 2. Gradually stir in water. Mix well until it forms a doughy consistency.
 3. With your hands form a ball with your dough and kneed it for at least 5 minutes. The longer you kneed your dough the smoother it will be. You can **paint** your creations with acrylic paints and seal with varnish or polyurethane spray. You can let your salt dough creations air dry, however salt dough can also be dried in the oven.
- Bake** at 200 F until your creation is dry.

High School Hunting Camp

On Oct 23 10 of our grade 9 - 12 students travelled to Hay River, NWT for a hunting camp. Although no big games was gathered, the students did shoot a beaver, snared rabbits and shot chickens. The students learned how to skin these animals and then enjoyed eating them. 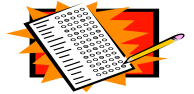


Grade 8/9 Girls Volleyball

Provincial Achievement Results Grades 6 and 9



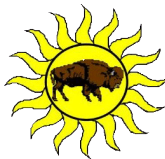
